

Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA)

Allocated to states for clean diesel projects

Pederal Grant Program:


National competitive grants and rebates to fund projects using certified diesel emission reduction technologies



House

Bipartisan legislation pending to reauthorize at

\$100 million/year through 2022



Targeted Air Shed Grants (TASG)

- Designed to target most polluted areas
- For nonattainment areas ranked in top five most polluted areas for ozone, annual PM2.5, and 24-hour PM2.5

TASG Annual SCAQMD Appropriation Received

FY2015 \$10 million \$0

FY2016 \$20 million \$2.48 million

FY2017 \$30 million TBD (*RFA closes 10/18*)

SCAQMD has received 8.3% of the total amount disbursed to date.

U.S. Clean Air Investment & Revitalization Act Proposal



Block grant program

To help states meet federal attainment standards (via incentives, new technology, air monitoring, helping businesses, etc.)



Clean construction equipment provision

For federal Infrastructure projects to increase federal share by 10% for projects using the cleanest construction equipment available



Clean Infrastructure

A 50% cut in the local match requirement for projects that incentivize clean technologies.



Clean Air Revolving Loan Fund

Capitalization grants to each state for their own Fund to help businesses in nonattainment areas obtain equipment, materials, and vehicles that reduce emissions.

What Have We Been Doing?

DERA

- Joined DERA Coalition
- Signed onto letters supporting increased FY2018 DERA Funding
- Initiated letters urging \$100 million appropriation in FY 2018 with 45 agencies and organizations from across the nation
- Signed onto letters supporting DERA Reauthorization bill (for \$100 million/yr through 2022)
- Four trips to DC (with fifth pending at end of August) to urge support for DERA funding and reauthorization

TASG

- r Four trips to DC (with fifth pending at end of August) to urge support for increased TASG funding
- Working to remove the arbitrary cap on TASG grants imposed by EPA

US CAIR

(& 5% For Clean Air)

- Developed US CAIR proposal
- Adapted proposal for request to set-aside 5% of Federal Infrastructure Bill for Clean Air
- Four trips to DC (with fifth pending at end of August) to urge support for 5% set-aside
- Met with EPA, DOT, CEQ, Key Senators and House Members
- Pitched concept to other air districts and state environmental agencies nationwide
- Developing a coalition in support of US CAIR and 5% set-aside.
- Seeking support for concept with OEMs and other businesses and industry groups
