On October 22, 2021, South Coast AQMD received an Air Toxics Inventory Report (ATIR) for the All American Asphalt facility located in the city of Irvine (AAA). We identified deficiencies in the ATIR and rejected the ATIR in our November 5, 2021 letter which identified those deficiencies. We have since received the revised ATIR on December 7, 2021. Following review of this revised ATIR, we have determined that some minor corrections¹ are necessary. Therefore, in accordance with South Coast AQMD Rule 1402 (d)(f)(D), South Coast AQMD staff have modified the ATIR to address the necessary corrections and are approving the modified ATIR. The corrected ATIR and associated Emissions Inventory File will be provided to you in electronic format. In accordance with South Coast AQMD's *AB 2588 and Rule 1402 Supplemental Guidelines*, AAA is required to use this corrected ATIR for the Health Risk Assessment (HRA) for your facility, which is due on February 3, 2022.
