

Proposed Rule 1410 Postcard comments to the Governing Board Members

Over the months leading up to the February 1, 2019 Board Meeting, the South Coast AQMD received postcards from the following individuals with the message below:

Dear SCAQMD Board,

Thank you for your work on Rule 1410. I support an SCAQMD rule replacing Modified HydroFluoric acid (MHF) with a safe catalyst within four years of rule adoption. Mitigation measures alone are insufficient.

The South Bay and Harbor area's high population density, plus the possibility of a release triggered by disasters like earthquakes, fires, and terrorist attacks, means that MHF alkylation is too great a risk to tolerate in southern California. As the SCAQMD staff concluded in August 2017, there is no conclusive evidence that MHF is safer than HF.

Please act for safety and eliminate this risk as soon as possible.
